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## 1.0 VISION

- All students having the opportunity to participate during their school life
- Students learning to play cooperatively and develop confidence and discipline in a competitive team situation.
- Students refining their understanding of rules and skills involved in team sport
- Involves students in Year 5/6 with Gr 4's filling teams

## 2.0 ACTION

- 2.1 Provide an interschool sport competition for students in years 5 and 6 with Grade 4 students filling teams where required.
- 2.2 Promote attitudes of good sporting behaviour and cooperation in accordance with the Victorian Primary Schools Sports Association Code of Behaviour.
- 2.3 Ensure sport is an enjoyable experience and promotes positive life-long attitudes towards participation and fitness.
- 2.4 Promote in students a sense of pride in being selected to represent the school.
- 2.5 Maintain membership of the Watsonia District Primary Schools Sports Association and participate in fixtures organised by that body.
- 2.6 Arrange for a school representative to attend W.D.P.S.S.A. meetings.
- 2.7 Encourage teachers, and where possible, parents to be involved in coaching umpiring tasks.
- 2.8 Ensure that students have training in their chosen sport.
- 2.9 Invite a range of sporting bodies to take clinics and coaching sessions.
- 2.10 Keep attendance records of student participation in interschool sport
- 2.11 Provide interest based activities for students not participating in interschool sport.
- 2.12 Ensure that as many students as possible have the opportunity to participate in their preferred sport, rotating players if required and select the best possible team chosen to represent the school in finals.
- 2.13 Ensure that school uniform or appropriate clothing and footwear are worn when representing the school.
- 2.14 Arrange for a member of each sporting team to report on their team's performance through providing a written report for the newsletter.
- 2.15 School sport team selection is influenced by consistent adherence to the school's behaviour and discipline policy.
